☒ 1. THE SCALE

“One Spark Can Light Many Flames”

1 Donor = Up to 7 Lives Saved

(From Lesson 1: The Domino Effect)

One single act of kindness can ripple across many lives.
A donor may restore breath, sight, movement, strength, or time.
This is why donation is seen as a rare, powerful gift, not just a medical procedure.

☒ 2. THE CATALYST

“A Conversation Unlocks the Chain Reaction”

8 out of 10 families say YES if they know the person’s wishes

(From Lesson 5: The Catalyst of Consent)

Talking with your family is the key that “activates” the decision.
Certainty reduces stress and increases confidence.
Even a short conversation at home can move a family from 40% → 80% consent.

☒ 3. THE TIMELINE

“The Gift That Restores the Future Map”

Donation helps young people reclaim their “future timeline.”

(From Lesson 4: The Hourglass – Time Restored)

Many recipients are young people whose futures were paused by illness.
Donation can allow them to return to school, sport, friendships, and milestones.
The “Future Map” is a symbol of how the gift restores possibility and hope.

☒ 4. THE SYSTEM

“Alchemy Is Rare – And So Is Donation”

Donation is a rare and special event, requiring the perfect circumstances.

(From Lesson 3: The Vault & The System)

Key facts students should remember:
Only a small number of people can become organ donors (specific medical conditions required).

This is why every donor is considered a hero, and every decision matters.
The system relies on teams of specialists – the “Guild of Helpers” – working together.
