(Eight large tiles: 1 Donor + 7 Recipients)

# THE DONOR

A single generous person whose act of kindness begins the entire chain reaction. Their decision to give the Gift of Life or the Gift of Sight creates hope for many others.

The donor represents the starting domino — without them, nothing else in the chain can happen.

# HEART RECIPIENT

This person receives a healthy heart and gets the chance to live a full, active life again.

They regain energy, strength, and the ability to enjoy everyday activities with their loved ones.



### LUNG RECIPIENT

This person can breathe freely again and return to the life they missed.

They can walk, play, laugh, talk, and move without struggle. Every breath is a gift.

#### LIVER RECIPIENT

A lifesaving gift brings their body back into balance and helps them recover their strength.

They are able to return to school, work, or family life, feeling healthier each day.

# KIDNEY RECIPIENT

This person receives the freedom to live without exhausting treatments.

They can travel, play sports, return to hobbies, and enjoy time with family without constant medical appointments.

# CORNEA RECIPIENT

Someone can see clearly again – faces, books, sunlight, stars.

A restored sense of sight helps them learn, explore, and reconnect with the world.

# **BONE & TISSUE RECIPIENT**

This person regains strength, movement, or the ability to walk again after injury or illness.

Tissue donation improves mobility, reduces pain, and restores independence.

# SKIN RECIPIENT

This person receives healing and protection after burns or severe injury.

Skin grafts can save lives by preventing infection and supporting major recovery.
