Mission Briefing: An Alchemist can prepare the perfect potion, but if they don't say the Incantation (the words), the magic won't spark. In donation, the "Incantation" is the Family Conversation. Today, you will analyze the data that proves why talking is the most powerful thing you can do, and you will script your own "Catalyst Code."

Part I: The Catalyst Data (The "Why")

The Fact: In Australia, doctors always ask the family for the final "OK" (Consent).

Scenario A: The Silent Path (Family DOES NOT know wishes).

- **Consent Rate:** 4 out of 10.
- **Question:** Why is this number so low? What is the family feeling?

Scenario B: The Spoken Path (Family KNOWS wishes).

- **Consent Rate:** 8 out of 10.
- **Question:** How does knowing make their decision easier?



Part 2: The "Cringe" Factor

List 2 reasons why this conversation feels awkward (e.g., fear of death, seems weird/random).

Reframe: Instead of talking about dying, think of it as talking about the kind of person you want to be.
